Designing Great Rubrics

Review the pdf, <u>Designing Great Rubrics</u> by Michael Simkins. In the handout Michael lists 10 important tips for creating great rubrics.

- 1. Don't make task-specific rubrics
- 2. Don't be excessively general
- 3. Avoid dysfunctional detail
- 4. Focus on a limited number of dimensions (Criteria)
- 5. Use key, teachable criteria
- 6. Use measurable criteria
- 7. Select (rating levels) descriptors carefully
- 8. Aim for four levels (rating levels)
- 9. Keep the "distance" between levels (points) equal
- 10. Include students in creating or adapting the rubric
