#### **SLCC HISTORY**

South Louisiana Community College (SLCC) was created by Act 1369 of the 1997 Louisiana regular legislative session. The College was established as a comprehensive, multi-campus public two-year institution of higher education and was designated to serve the Acadiana region comprised of the eight civil parishes of Acadia, Evangeline, Iberia, Lafayette, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, and Vermilion.

Operations of the College were launched February I, 1998, and it offered coursework to 31 students at its New Iberia location beginning in May 1998. Classes were offered in Lafayette beginning in January 1999 and in Franklin during the Fall 1999 semester.

At its inception, SLCC was a member of the University of Louisiana System. When the Louisiana Community and Technical College System (LCTCS) was organized in 1999, SLCC joined all of Louisiana's community and technical colleges as an LCTCS institution, governed by the Louisiana Board of Regents for Higher Education.

The Louisiana Technical College System, was established in 1930. In 2005, it was organized into regions and the Louisiana Technical College (LTC), Region 4, comprised of the seven technical college campuses, was created. In 2010, the LTC, Region 4 was renamed Acadiana Technical College (ATC) and reorganized as a single college, with campuses in Abbeville, Crowley, Franklin, Lafayette, New Iberia, Opelousas, St. Martinville, and Ville Platte.

In June 2012, Govenor Bobby Jindal signed Act 767 merging ATC and SLCC into a new institution, and the LCTCS Board of Supervisors approved the merger effective July 1, 2012. The "new" comprehensive SLCC enrolled more than 7,600 students in the Fall 2012 semester. In June 2013, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools granted approval of the merger and continued full accreditation of SLCC. Through a statewide realignment in 2017 and 2018, SLCC expanded its educational footprint to Morgan City.

South Louisiana Community College currently offers more than 50 programs leading to associate degrees, technical diplomas, and certificates. The College also offers a wide range of short-term workforce instruction and training as well as adult education and HiSET testing. In total, SLCC educates approximately 12,000 students annually. The College is proud of its history and looks forward to continuing to provide outstanding educational opportunities for students throughout the greater Acadiana region.

### COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER



Blaise Zuschlag, Executive Vice President and Chief Administrative Officer with Acadian Companies oversees the IT, Procurement, Fleet Logistics, and Billing departments. He also works on special projects and strategic initiatives including acquisitions, innovation, and governmental relations at Acadian.

Blaise joined Acadian Companies in February 2013 and has held roles as a business analyst, director of administration, and most recently, chief of staff. Prior to Acadian, he served as an advisor for JP Morgan Chase's Private Bank.

A native of Lafayette, LA, Blaise earned a bachelor's degree in finance from LSU and an MBA from Tulane University. He is a graduate of Leadership Lafayette Class 24 and serves on numerous local nonprofit boards, including serving as former President of Lafayette Education Foundation, former Committee Member of the Evangeline Area Boy Scouts Swamp Base Capital Campaign, current Chairman of the Holy Family Catholic School Steering Committee, and President of Holy Family Catholic School Advisory Council.

He also serves as the current Chairman of the One Acadiana Board of Directors, and a current member of Love Our Schools' Board of Directors. Blaise also serves as a Board Member of First National Bank of Louisiana.

#### ACADEMIC REGALIA

American academic regalia is an inheritance primarily from Britain. The custom of wearing academic gowns, caps, and hoods dates back to the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> centuries. The most common articles of daily attire were long-flowing gowns and cloaks, with hoods attached for headwear; subsequently, hats became prominent. In England, details of scholars' apparel and occasions for use were strictly prescribed by university statutes.

The origin of the Oxford "mortarboard" cap is a mystery. It may well have evolved from forcing the rather square-shaped, outdoor biretta over the close-fitting, indoor skull cap commonly worn by university scholars in medieval times. Gowns for all three degree levels are similar in shape, although sleeve patterns differ. Doctoral gowns are faced with velvet, with three bars per sleeve.

The hood is the most distinctive feature of academic dress. The color and style distinguish degree level, college or university, and discipline, although proliferation of fields and institutions does not always allow easy identification. Hoods are all black, and they become longer and wider with more advanced degrees. All are lined inside with silk in the academic colors of the institution that conferred the degree. The outer velvet trim on the hood, which becomes broader with the higher degrees, indicates the academic discipline.

#### **COLLEGE MEDALLION**

The medallion is a symbol of the office worn by the chancellor on official and ceremonial occasions. SLCC's medallion is a replica of the official seal of the College, and it is suspended with the names of the College's campuses. The chancellor wears the medallion at academic ceremonies, such as commencement and while serving as a delegate representing the College in other ceremonial rituals.



#### **COLLEGE MACE**

The academic mace is a symbol of authority dating from medieval times when knights carried them during processions with their kings. As the tradition grew, the mace became a ceremonial symbol of peaceful leadership. Today, a college's mace is carried before platform-party dignitaries and the chancellor during commencement, inaugural, and other academic ceremonial processions.

South Louisiana Community College's mace is handcrafted from cypress, the state tree of Louisiana, and was specially designed to represent the institution.

At the bottom of the mace is a small ball that symbolizes the College's origin. Next is an expanding shaft that represents the student body's increasing knowledge and expansion. Two rings at the shaft's base symbolize the merging of Acadiana Technical College with South Louisiana Community College, and a series of rings near the middle represent the innumerable ways in which the College impacts Louisiana residents' quality of life.

The two rings at the top of the shaft symbolize excellence and integrity, the College's guiding tenets. The large ball near the top represents the College's faculty and staff that guide students on their educational journeys, and the finial at the mace's peak points both the College and our students toward the future.



#### **GRADUATE HONORS**

#### CHANCELLOR'S HONOR GRADUATES (\*\*)

Students with the highest academic achievement (cumulative grade point average of 3.8 or higher) receive this prestigious honor and wear gold cords during commencement.

#### **HONOR GRADUATES (\*)**

Students who earn a GPA of 3.5 to 3.79 are considered Honor Graduates and wear white honor cords during commencement.

#### **HONOR SOCIETY (§)**

South Louisiana Community College is the home of the Beta Xi Omega Chapter of the Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) International Honor Society. This organization acknowledges and encourages scholarship among two-year college students. Students invited to become members are recognized for their academic achievements. At commencement, PTK members wear blue and gold cords and/or branded stoles.

#### MILITARY SERVICE

SLCC honors the military service of its students, faculty, and staff through the awarding of military honor cords. This honor cord is red, white, and blue and is worn by those who have served/are currently serving in the United States military.

#### LISTING OF GRADUATES

The appearance of a name in this program is presumptive of graduation, but it is not to be regarded as conclusive. Students whose names are listed twice in the program are receiving two degrees. Due to late applications, the names of some students who are graduating are not listed in this program.


