



Your calendar displays the SLCC academic dates as well as any campus events that you decide to add to your schedule from the Events tile.




The Campus Guide

You can also invite friends to download the app, and get in touch with tech support!






The Community Feed


The community feed is the social hub of the app. Here you can **connect with other students: ask questions, make friends, share information!**






Profile, Courses, Friends




Settings


There are two important locations for settings.

The first is on your profile tab.

If you click on the gear icon in the top right corner, you can access the **general app**settings (as seen to the right).
